POSITION TITLE: Painter/Blast Booth Operator

SUMMARY OF THIS POSITION

Under the supervision of the Plant Manager, the incumbent will work to ensure parts are adequately prepared for painting and painted according to the appropriate specifications.

LOCATION:

The job will be carried out on site in Building A of PhiBer Manufacturing, 108 New Hope Drive, Crystal City, MB R0K 0N0.

OUTLINE OF DUTIES

- All Employee duties as described in PhiBer's Employee Handbook.
- Pre-paint responsibilities:
 - Clean and dry-off parts.
 - Sand and prime parts as needed.
- Apply electrostatic paint on parts according to manufacturer's specifications.
- Perform quality checks on painted parts.
- Workspace organization and clean up.
- Perform routine maintenance of paint equipment.
- Participate in trainings for skill development.
- Assist in the blast booth as required.
 - Inspection, maintenance and start-up of the blast.
 - Preparation of steel parts for blasting.
 - Blast steel to prep for paint.
- Perform other related duties as requested.

SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE

Basic Knowledge

The position requires the incumbent to have knowledge of, and experience with:

- Self-motivated
- Team oriented
- Organization skills
- Prioritization skills
- Mechanical skills
- General power tool usage
- Blast/painting skills

The ability to communicate well both orally and in writing is required.

Comprehension and Judgment
